

What's that food?

Step 1: Get in groups of four





Step 2: Get a menu

Scenario: A new restaurant has opened in Seoul, and the chefs have asked you to help them name the foods. Based on the descriptions, what are some names you think would work for these foods?



Step 3: In your groups, decide what the name of the menu item is, based on the description.

Answers

What are these foods?

What's that food?

A bed of lettuce and spinach topped with tomatoes, onions, carrots, and your choice of dressing. (Some people even add cheese!)

Green Salad



What's that Food?

Italian noodles in a <u>creamy</u>, <u>cheesy</u> white sauce. Topped with <u>grilled</u> chicken, <u>parmesan</u> cheese, and green onions. (Served with a side of Italian garlic bread.)

Chicken Alfredo Pasta



What's that food?

A <u>delicious</u> beef patty, <u>grilled</u> and <u>seasoned</u> with garlic, salt, and pepper. Served between two buns with lettuce, tomato, onion, cheese, ketchup, and <u>sour</u> pickles. (Served with a side of fries)

Hamburger



What's that food?

<u>Spicy</u> beef <u>strips</u> with avocado, tomato, black beans, and rice. <u>Served</u> in warm flour <u>tortillas</u>. (This food is from Mexico!)

Tacos



What's that food?

Curly egg noodles, carrots, and celery <u>cooked</u> in a warm chicken broth.

(This dish is sure to make you feel better if you are sick!)


Ordering Food

When ordering food at a restaurant, here are some common phrases you could use

Phrases

- •May I please have…?
- ol would like to order...
- ∘I'll have a/ the...

Listen Carefully



Dialogue

- Waiter: Excuse me. Have you decided on something?
- Customer 1: Yes, I think so. <u>I'll have the</u> Chicken Alfredo pasta.
- Waiter: Great. How about for you?
- Customer 2: I would like to order the mixed green salad.


Ordering Food

If you have questions about what you are ordering, here are some other phrases you could use

Questions

- Does this dish have...?
- How much does it cost?
- ∘ Is this dish...?

Listen carefully



Dialogue

Waiter: Excuse me. Have you decided on something?

Customer: I am not sure. Do these tacos have beef in them?

Waiter: Yes, they do.

Customer: Okay. Are the tacos spicy?

Waiter: No, they are not spicy at all.

Now, time for you to try!

Dialogue for you to use

Waiter: Hello. What would you like to order?

Customer 1: I would like to have <u>Tacos</u>. Is it <u>spicy</u> (spicy, good, fresh)?

Waiter: Yes/ No

Customer 2: I would like to order the <u>a hamburger</u> How much does it cost?

Waiter: It costs 10 dollars

Customer 3: I would like to try the Chicken Noodle Soup.

Waiter: Yes, of course. I will bring out your food shortly
